A refund of the amount paid minus \$50 (to cover costs incurred by the program) will be issued if your child withdraws prior to the first game. A deposit of \$100 will be collected upon the issuance of program equipment, and an additional deposit of \$50 will be collected for fundraising. Refunds and deposits will be given upon the return of all equipment and completion of fundraising. No registration fee refunds will be issued after the first game.</p> <p>Physical Exam: All players are required to have a current physical completed by a physician <u>using the designated MSHSAA form (attached)</u>. Physical exams can be no older than six months prior to the start of the season and <u>must be turned in before players will be allowed on the field for practice or games.</u></p> <p>Volunteering: Families are required to work at least once during the season. Contact Team Organizers for work duty opportunities. A \$100 deposit (per family) will be collected and returned upon fulfillment of duty. Participants will be given the opportunity to buy out of work duty for \$100. (Note, we would rather have your service than your money)</p> <p>Player/Parent/Guardian Consent and Warnings: I/We give permission for my child/ward to participate in Jr. Pirates football. I/We realize that participation in football involves the potential injury which is inherent in all sports. I/We acknowledge that even with the best coaching and use of the most advanced protective equipment and strict observance of rules, injuries are still a possibility. On rare occasions these injuries can be so severe as to result in total disability, paralysis, or even death. I/We acknowledge that participation in</p>

the sport is an acceptance of risk of injury. In order to minimize this risk, it is necessary that you as a participant be aware of and abide by certain safety rules and guidelines. The helmet you wear is not to be used to butt, ram, or spear an opposing player. This is in violation of MSHSAA football rules and such use can result in severe injury to your opponent. No helmet can prevent all head or neck injuries that a player might receive while participating in football. You must also report all injuries and any illness to the athletic trainer or coaches as soon as they become evident to you.
